

Visitors and Designated Caregivers

We value and appreciate you coming to our Home. We would like to remind you that PPE requirements are different in health care then in community. Masks are required for the duration of your visit.

We would like to remind you that we are entering another season in which a variety of respiratory illnesses are common. It's not just COVID, there is influenza, RSV (respiratory syncytial virus) and the common cold. We are trying to prevent outbreaks from occurring in our home in order to prevent isolating your loved one. Outbreaks can occur in personal care homes at any time of year. For example, if your loved one were to contract RSV, they would be on isolation until their symptoms go away which could be longer then 10 days in most cases. Isolation can be difficult on residents' physical, social, emotional and cognitive well being. Outbreaks are difficult on residents and staff. At Rest Haven we are trying to balance between quality of life and prevention of illness.

We ask that you please follow the rules and guidelines set out by Shared Health and Southern Health - Santé Sud. Thank you for continued compliance, collaboration and community support.
