ABBY is an Activation Platform that invites residents to an activity they can easily do. There are games to play and plenty of stimuli to discover, and the time spent contributes to emotional well-being!

When activated, ABBY will play pre-selected or personalized and familiar pictures, videos, and songs. Residents ca successfully and independently relive memories and settle themselves by being thoroughly engaged. This time spent provides caregivers with a positive non-pharmacological intervention option.

ABBY is always available to residents even if a caregiver is not nearby. It was designed to invite residents to engage with their remaining abilities and interests. Using these abilities promotes independence, cognitive stimulation and physical activity. In addition, visiting children love to engage with a resident on an ABBY, reducing disruptions, and family members find it meaningful to engage with a resident when they visit.
