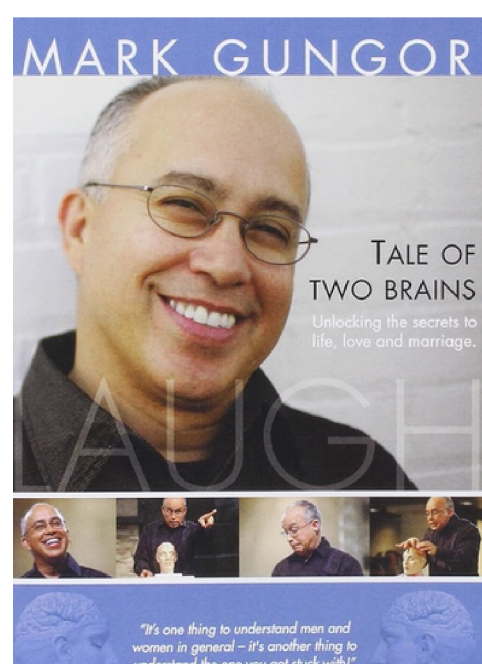
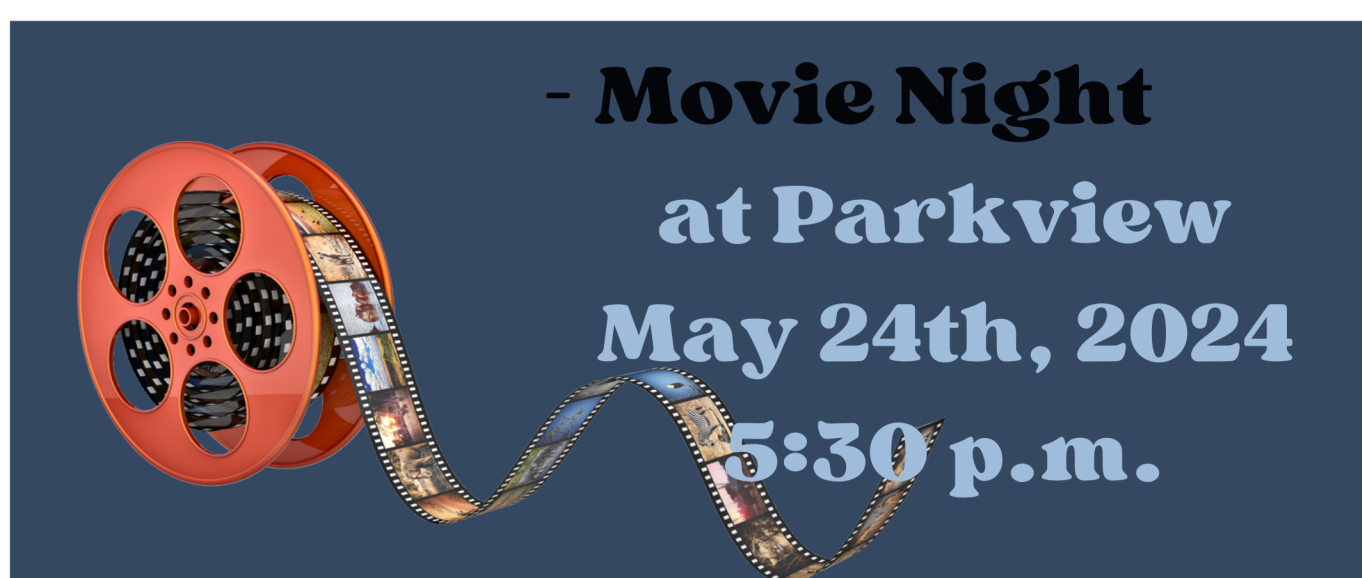

Taking some time to visit the cemetery and put flowers on the grave is another way.

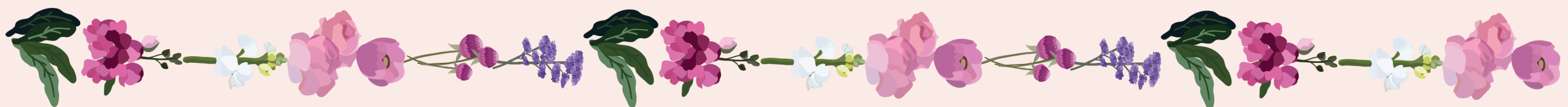
Someone asked, "I wonder if they celebrate Mother's Day in heaven?"
