sit unsupported, the only alternative to a tub bath was a bed bath. This lovely Cadillac of shower chairs allows those that are unable to sit unsupported, a full wash in the shower of their own room. As we have educated staff on the use of this chair, there have been so many moments when their eyes lit up as they think of a resident that would benefit from this alternative to tub

baths. I look forward to hearing our success stories over the next few months as we see it put into use."

Its adjustable features are not only supportive and secure for the resident, but the care givers as well, allowing a recline position to wash hair, and feet .
