But as they sailed he fell asleep (Luke 8:23).  
What an interesting line in the middle of this story!

Do we ever think about  
the human side of Jesus' nature?  
Likely exhausted from the busyness  
of ministering to many people,  
he was finally able to rest as they sailed across the  
water.

As he did so, though, he was lulled to sleep  
from the rocking of the boat,  
and the lapping of the waves.

This demonstrates how Jesus faced  
the same types of situations we face.  
Hebrews 4:15 says He was "tempted like as we are,  
yet without sin."

But then the story takes a turn.  
...there came down a storm of wind on the lake;  
and they were filled with water,  
and were in jeopardy.

Isn't it interesting how the storm came  
after He fell asleep?

As if it was lurking around the corner,  
just waiting for the opportunity.

The reality, though, is that the terrain  
around the Sea of Galilee, is such that strong winds  
can easily funnel through the mountains  
and quickly become powerful storms at sea.

Then he arose, and rebuked the wind  
and the raging of the water...  
and there was a calm.

Jesus said the word and everything became still  
what a testimony to the power of His word!

At His bidding, any storm becomes calm.

How about our situations?

Do we ever question where God is?

While Psalm 77:9 asks
