Fall is such a beautiful time of year! In seeing the green of summer change to the gold, yellow, and red of autumn, we marvel at another display of God's glory.

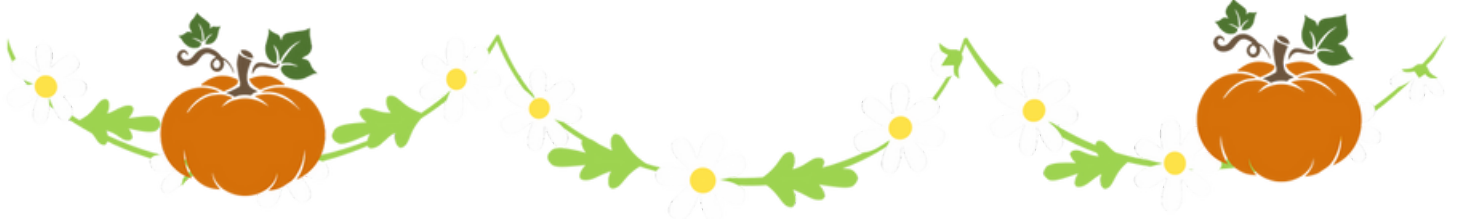
Does it remind you of another place?
