**Mrs. A. S. Bridgewater wrote the words:**

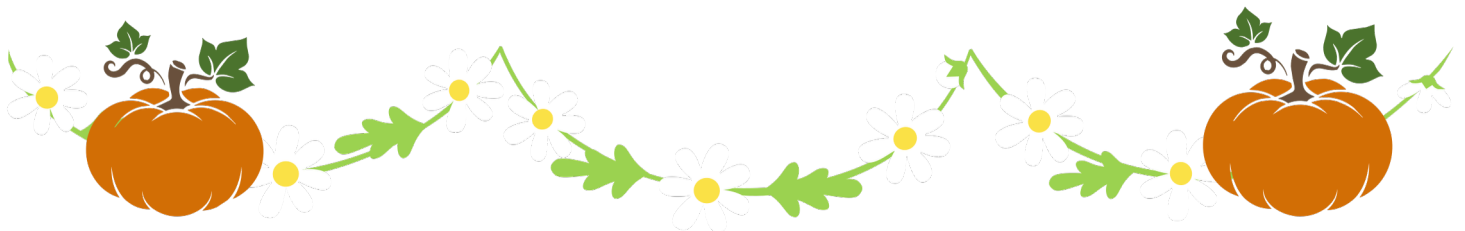
*How beautiful heaven must be, Sweet home of the happy and free;*

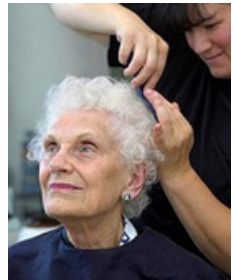
