How does God comfort us?

A good question to ask in this time around Remembrance Day or in any time of difficulty or loss.

When Jesus met up with a funeral procession on the outskirts of Nain, He found a widow grieving the loss of her only son (Luke 7:11). How did He respond? By intervening in the miraculous way of raising her son back to life!

Does God always comfort in this way, by solving all the problems we encounter? This is what we may like, but God doesn't always do it that way. Even the apostle Paul was disappointed when God didn't heal him the way he asked. God did provide strength, though, as he said, "...My grace is sufficient for thee...my strength is made perfect in weakness...." (II Corinthians 12:9).

How can strength be made perfect in weakness?

Doing things in our own strength can make us feel self-sufficient, like the child who asserts, "I can do it myself!" Times of weakness, though, force us to look elsewhere for strength, which can motivate us to seek the Lord. Jesus does encourage us to trust and not to be afraid (John 14).

So why did Jesus comfort the widow of Nain the way He did? This special miracle served as a sign to show who He was—God's only Son. Though God does miracles today, we don't see them as often as in the early church. But what God does give is grace and strength for each moment, which are also signs that can encourage others as they observe us continuing on despite the challenges of life.

This month we also want to honor the memory of some Rest Haven residents who recently passed away. Condolences to the families of Anne Loewen, Maria Doerksen, Cornie Thiessen, and Eva Kehler.

May God grant you the strength to continue on, no matter what you're facing today.

Social Work Corner

Relationships, Helping residents make their house a home.

Every care setting operates better when those living and working in that care setting enjoy authentic relationships with one another. These relationships are particularly important in long term care, where older adults receive essential services and supports in the same place where they live. Because our facility is both a care setting and a home, our care team has a special obligation to encourage and support relationship building.

Positive social relationships can positively influence life satisfaction, well-being, and the ability to thrive, as well as decrease feelings of loneliness among older adults. Strategies that our care team often utilize for promoting development and maintenance of relationships may include:



- Introducing new residents to others with similar interests, hobbies and life experiences. This often happens through gathering of information for social histories, recreational activities and discussions.
- Placement of residents in the facility and consideration of the residents ability to ambulate. Physical proximity is key for the development of friendly peer relationships. Mobility also helps residents remove themselves from the company of others whom they may at times find stressful or overstimulating. We often hear during admission planning, that a resident knows another resident from the community or that they may be related. We sometimes hear that their preference is to be in the same home. We also hear them when they say that they want to be close, but not in the same home.
- Encouraging residents to actively involve themselves in events will give them the opportunity to engage with other residents. With there being a focus of the time spent together, conversation should come easier. It's also likely that they'll find themselves with people who have similar interests, which always helps to promote a bond.

As we welcome our new residents and families to Rest Haven, let us not forget the power of social relationships with staff and peers for older adults in long term care settings.

The Mobile Dental Hygiene Experience

Initial Appointment: We will provide a thorough examination of the teeth and evaluate your specific oral health care needs. We will relay our findings to your dentist and ask for consent to have your dental cleaning done. There is no charge for this service.

Procedure: A cleaning includes the following:

- 1.Dental Scaling
- 2.Dental Polishing
- 3.Fluoride Treatment
- 4.Denture Cleaning
- 5.Oral Cancer Screening
- 6.SDF Treatment (if required)
- 7.Personalized Dental Care Plan

Logistics: We bill your insurance directly without the cost of your deductible. You will receive a printout of your statement once treatment is completed. If you do not have insurance, we offer our services at a flat rate of \$90.00. This includes all the services mentioned above.

Follow Up Appointments: A follow up cleaning appointment will be scheduled within 4-6 months depending on a mutual understanding of your specific dental health care needs.
