Short History of "Silent Night"

"The backstory is that the priest went for a walk before he wrote it, and he looked out over a very quiet, winter-laden town," says composer/conductor John Conahan, "He was inspired...the town was at peace." It was Christmas Eve, 1818, when the now-famous carol was first performed as Stille Nacht Heilige Nacht. Joseph Mohr, the young priest who wrote the lyrics, played the guitar and sang along with Franz Xaver Gruber, the choir director who had written the melody. Even on the battlefield during World War I, when, during a temporary truce on Christmas Eve, soldiers sang carols from home.
