**ACCOUNTABILITY:** Nutrition and Food Services Manager

**POSITION PURPOSE:** Reporting to the Nutrition and Food Services Manager, the Dietary Aide is responsible for the completion of assigned tasks in relation to the safe preparation, serving, and distribution of nutritious meals to residents and tenants. The incumbent is responsible for serving meals to the staff and visitors, performing cashier duties, following proper sanitation safety guidelines. This is in addition to following established standards, departmental/regional policies and procedures and government regulations and legislation. The incumbent will exercise the appropriate level of initiative and independent judgment in determining work priorities, work methods, to be employed and action to be taken on unusual matters.

The Dietary Aide will interact with residents, visitors, family members, visitors and co-workers on a daily basis. It is important to understand that meals and meal times are a very important and enjoyable part of the resident's day and it is therefore imperative that this position make every effort to make this a positive time of interaction for those we serve. The position functions in a manner that is consistent with resident Bill of Rights, the Mission, Vision, and Values and Policies and Procedures of HavenGroup.
