Victoria Day is a federal Canadian public holiday observed on the last Monday preceding May 25 to honour Queen Victoria,

who is known as the "Mother of Confederation". The holiday has existed in Canada since at least 1845, originally on Victoria's natural birthday, May 24.

Victoria Day is a federal statutory holiday, as well as a holiday in six of Canada's ten provinces and all three of its territories.

The holiday has always been a distinctly Canadian observance and continues to be celebrated across the country.

It is informally considered the start of the summer season in Canada.
