As we reflect on the accomplishments of the HavenGroup Foundation, we are truly grateful for all that we have been given.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone who attended our Evening Fundraiser that was held at Friedensfeld Hall in March 2025. It was a successful evening and all the generosity of your financial support is truly appreciated.

Each month, HavenGroup takes time to appreciate all the different disciplines that work in the organization. In the month of June it includes Chaplaincy. The Chaplaincy program at HavenGroup is funded by the Member Churches through the Foundation. This support has allowed HavenGroup to have two Chaplains on staff, Peter Berg, full time position and Randi Rempel, part time .6 position.

HavenGroup's focus on Faith can significantly enhance the quality of life and well-being of the people residing and working in our homes. Our Chaplains can support religious practices, offer companionship, and help find meaning and purpose. This can be particularly beneficial for those nearing the end of life, helping them cope with fear and find comfort.

Spiritual Care is a Core Value:

HavenGroup recognizes the importance of spiritual care as a key aspect of overall well-being and living our values.

Supporting Religious Practices:

Providing opportunities for religious services, prayer, and scripture reading can help residents/tenants connect with their faith communities and maintain their spiritual practices.

Addressing Spiritual Needs:

Chaplains can help residents/tenants explore their spiritual beliefs and address any concerns or questions they may have.

Promoting Resilience and Meaning:

Spiritual care can help residents/tenants find meaning in their lives, even in the face of challenges and limitations.

End-of-Life Care:

Addressing spiritual concerns can help staff, residents/tenants and their families cope with the end-of-life process, reducing fear and promoting a sense of peace.

Importance of Spiritual Care Providers:

Our Chaplains can assess residents' spiritual needs, offer support, and coordinate with faith communities.

Beyond Religious Services:

Spiritual care at HavenGroup can also encompass a broader range of activities, including, music, sharing of meals and other social gatherings, to foster a sense of community and belonging.
