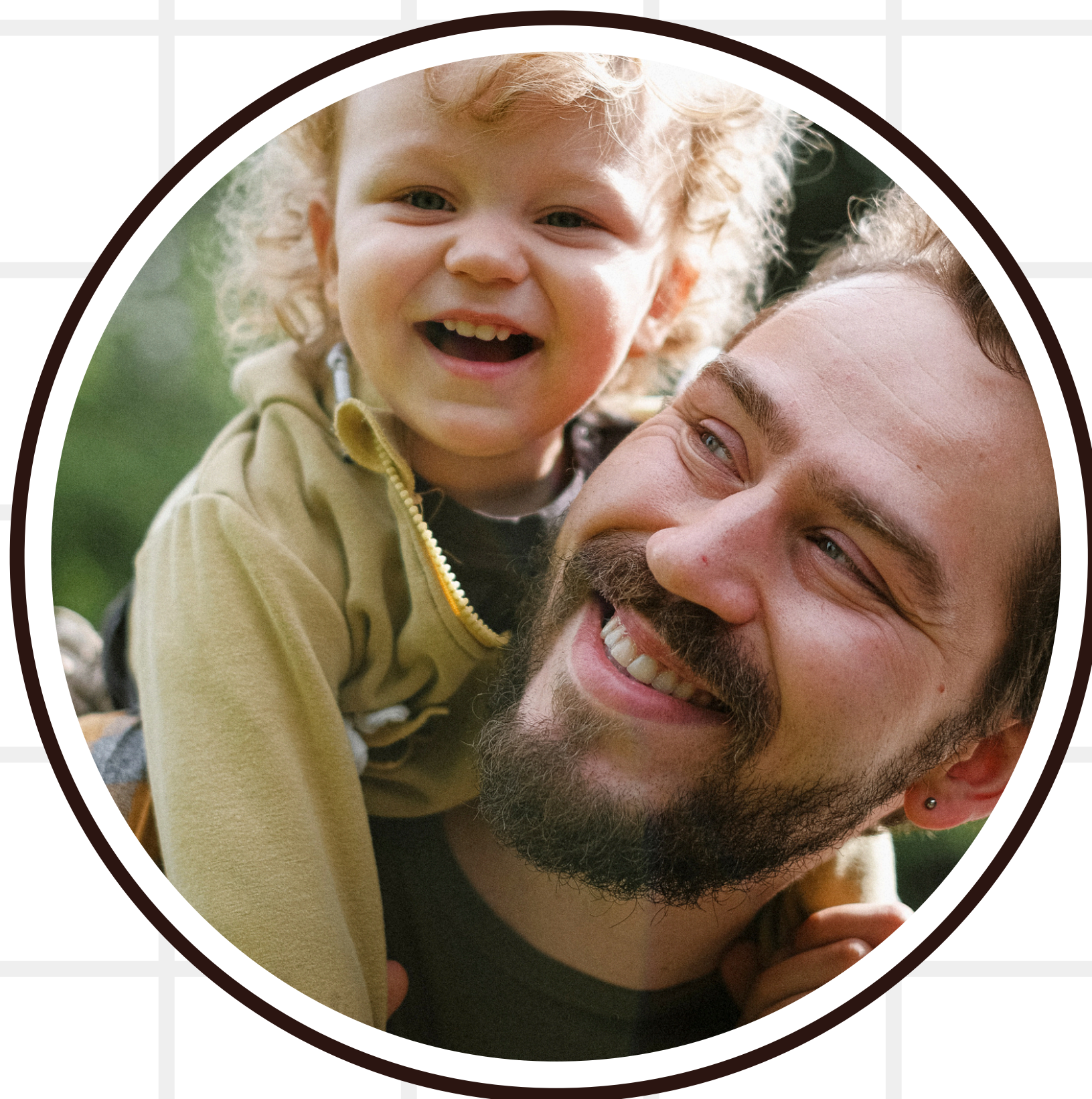

# From the Chaplain

## Happy Father's Day!

It was 1910 in Spokane, Washington,  
that Sonora Smart started the practice of celebrating Father's Day.  
She saw how mothers were honored on Mother's Day  
and felt fathers deserved the same honor,

especially as she remembered  
her own father raising the family after the death of her mother.

Honoring fathers goes back many years which  
we can even see in the 10 commandments  
where God commands us to honor our father and our mother  
and that we would be blessed for doing that.

For those whose fathers are no longer with them,  
Father's Day can be bittersweet.

While the sons and daughters are no longer able to spend time  
with their fathers, they can still honor them in various ways.  
Some honor their fathers with a rose, the official flower for Father's Day.

A red rose is given to honor a father still alive,  
while a white rose is used to honor a father who has died.

No matter the situation we are in, our Heavenly Father remains with us  
as we see in Psalm 68:5 where God is described as "a father to the fatherless."

We also see God's love portrayed in the parable of the prodigal son  
where the father "had compassion, and ran, and fell on (the son's) neck,  
and kissed him" (Luke 15:20).

How can we not but love and honor a Father who treats us like that?

May we continue to abide in the Father's love,  
no matter the situation we find ourselves in.
